We are on Zoom and have established an 800 number for those who wish to use their phone to connect and not be charged long distance. Our weekly invitation link can also be used by Wi-Fi connection. The Zoom computer connection or 800 number is a good way for you to have our service available to you and your family and friends **1(888) 788-0099** is the free 800 phone number. For Sunday worship the meeting ID is **886 7604 5376**, no personal ID is required. Just hit the # sign when asked for personal ID. If you have a smart phone you can enter with video connection or not. If you do not get in please call 385-234-1931 before 10 AM and I will try to help you connect.

The easiest way to come on Zoom by computer is to have an invitation email with a link. You will need to send your email address to me or Susan, so we can send out an invitation with a link to our meeting. If you notice someone missing from the email addresses in your email or want to invite someone you know, either forward this to them or send an email to Susan Roberts or Pastor Hank so we can include them in our ongoing email invitations if they desire.

**We are privileged and commanded by God to worship Him. Worship is the highest art form and good work that humans can do before and with God. Worship brings us into God's presence, where we first confess our sins and receive His forgiveness to enter His presence as well as receive His blessings for life now and in eternity. Worship establishes and maintains eternal fellowship with God. Worship is not an entertainment activity. Do not sit back and watch; true worship requires your active listening and participation. Even while muted, sing the hymns and speak the responses, prayers and confessions.**

Because of the second to second and a half lag-time between you and the source of the music or leading voice, unison participation requires us to mute our mic or phone if this feature is available, or cover the mouth-piece/mic. Only one voice should be heard responding to avoid confusion of the feedback and distract from our worship.. Our joyful noise is certainly heard by our Lord, but it is distracting to our worship concentration with the lag time. Remember, worship is not worship unless you are involved in the worship acts, so don't just watch, -- join in, listen, and participate.

You will have opportunity to speak to and greet each other both before and after worship. The actual worship will start at 10 AM, but we will establish our meeting for you to connect at or after 9:45 AM. You will come into the zoom waiting room and be brought in by the host or co-host ASAP. Your wait time will be very short.

We have opened up the church, so you can worship in it. **We will need to social distance as family units, wear masks, wash hands and enjoy fellowship together.** Cell Phones dialed into our zoom program will allow you to fellowship with and be active together in worship if you choose to worship from home. You are asked to mute your phone while service is going on and to worship normally. Communion is offered on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> Sundays after completion of the worship on zoom. Private communion is offered upon request. We will continue to utilize Zoom for Sunday worship as part of our outreach to the community and for those who are at home or traveling.

**SERMON Text: Mark 10:17 “What must I do to inherit eternal life?”**

**The Baptism of Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig**

*[The candidate, sponsors, and immediate family gather with the pastor at the font during the singing of the hymn below]*

**Baptismal Hymn LSB 605 “Father Welcomes”**

**Refrain:** Father welcomes all His children To His fam’ly through His Son.

Father giving His salvation, Life forever has been won.

1. Little children, come to Me, For My kingdom is of these.  
Life and love I have to give, Mercy for your sin. *Refrain:*
2. In the water, in the Word, In His promise, be assured:  
Those who are baptized and believe Shall be born again. *Refrain:*
3. Let us daily die to sin; Let us daily rise with Him,  
Walk in the love of Christ our Lord, Live in the peace of God. *Refrain:*

**P:** Dearly beloved, Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Matthew, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” In the last chapter of Mark our Lord promises, “Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved.” And the apostle Peter has written, “Baptism now saves you.”

**P:** The Word of God also teaches that we are all conceived and born sinful and are under the power of the devil until Christ claims us as His own. We would be lost forever unless delivered from sin, death, and everlasting condemnation. But the Father of all mercy and grace has sent His Son Jesus Christ, Who atoned for the sin of the whole world, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

*[Pastor addresses the parents]*

**P:** *How is your baby to be named?*

**R: Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig**

*[The pastor makes the sign of the holy cross upon the forehead and heart of the candidate while saying:]*

**P: Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig,** receive the sign of the holy cross both upon you (+) forehead and upon your (+) heart to mark you as one redeemed by Christ the crucified.

**P:** Let us pray. Almighty and eternal God, according to Your strict judgment You condemned the unbelieving world through the flood, yet according to Your great mercy You preserved believing Noah and his family, eight souls in all.

*You drowned hard-hearted Pharaoh and all his host in the Red Sea, yet led Your people Israel through the water on dry ground, foreshadowing this washing of Your Holy Baptism.*

*Through the Baptism in the Jordan of Your beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, You sanctified and instituted all waters to be a blessed flood and a lavish washing away of sin.*

*We pray that You would behold Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig according to Your boundless mercy and bless him with true faith by the Holy Spirit, that through this saving flood all sin in him, which has been inherited from Adam and which he himself has committed since birth, would be drowned and die.*

*Grant that he be kept safe and secure in the holy ark of the Christian Church, being separated from the multitude of unbelievers and serving Your Name at all times with a fervent spirit and a joyful hope, so that, with all believers in Your promise, he would be declared worthy of eternal life; through Jesus Christ, our Lord.*

**C: Amen.**

**P:** From ancient times the Church has observed the custom of appointing sponsors for baptismal candidates and catechumens. In the Evangelical Luther Church sponsors are to confess the faith expressed in the Apostles' Creed and taught in the Small Catechism. They are, whenever possible, to witness the Baptism of those they sponsor. They are to pray for them, support them in their ongoing instruction and nurture in the Christian faith, and encourage them toward the faithful reception of the Lord's Supper. They are at all times to be examples to them of the holy life of faith in Christ and love for the neighbor.

*[The pastor addresses the sponsors.]*

**P:** Is it your intention to serve Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig as sponsors in the Christian faith?

**R: Yes, with the help of God.**

**P:** God enable you both to will and to do this faithful and loving work and with His grace fulfill what we are unable to do.

**C: Amen**

**P:** Hear the Holy Gospel according to St. Mark.

*They brought young children to [Jesus] that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. Assuredly, I say to*

*you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it.” And He took them up in His arms, put His hands on them, and blessed them. (Mark 10:13-16 NKJV)*

*P: This is the Word of the Lord.*

**C: Thanks be to God**

*[The pastor places his hands on the head of the candidate, and the congregation joins in praying the LORD’S PRAYER]:*

**C: Our Father Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name, Thy kingdom come,  
Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven; give us this day our daily bread;  
and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us;  
and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.  
For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.**

*P: The Lord preserve your coming in and your going out from this time forth and even (+) forevermore.*

**C: Amen.**

*[Pastor addresses the candidate and the sponsors and asks the following questions which are answered by the sponsors.]*

*P: **Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig** do you renounce the devil?*

**R: Yes, I renounce him.**

*P: Do you renounce all his works?*

**R: Do you renounce all his ways?**

*P: Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth?*

**R: Yes, I believe.**

*P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.*

**R: Yes, I believe.**

*P: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life (+) everlasting.*

**R: Yes, I believe.**

*P: **Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig** do you desire to be baptized?*

**R: Yes, I do.**

*[ The pastor pours water three times on the head of the candidate while saying: ]*

*P: **Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig** I baptize you in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.*

*[The pastor places his hands on the head of the newly baptized while saying: ]*

*P: The almighty God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who has given you the new birth of water and the Spirit and has forgiven you all your sins, strengthen you with His grace to life (+) everlasting.*

**C: Amen**

*[The pastor lights a baptismal candle from the paschal candle and gives it to the newly baptized sponsor while saying:]*

*P: Receive this burning light to show that you have received Christ Who is the Light of the world. Live always in the light of Christ, and be ever watchful for His coming, that you may meet Him with joy and enter with Him into the marriage feast of the Lamb in His kingdom, which shall have no end.*

[ *The newly baptized is welcomed in to the family of God with the following:*]

*P: In Holy Baptism God the Father has made you a member of His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and an heir with us of all the treasures of heaven in the one holy Christian and apostolic Church. We receive you in Jesus' Name as our brother in Christ, that together we might hear His Word, receive His gifts, and proclaim the praises of Him Who called us out of darkness into His marvelous light.*

**C Amen. We welcome you in the Name of the Lord**

*P: Please rise*

**P:** *Let us pray. Almighty and most merciful God and Father, we thank and praise You that You graciously preserve and enlarge Your family and have granted Santiago Juan Roberto Uhlig the new birth in Holy Baptism and made him a member of Your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and an heir of Your heavenly kingdom. We humbly implore You that, as he has now become Your child, You would keep him in his baptismal grace, that according to Your good pleasure he may faithfully grow to lead a godly life to the praise and honor of Your holy Name and finally, with all Your saints, obtain the promised inheritance in heaven; through Jesus Christ, our Lord.*

**C: Amen**

*P: Peace (+) be with you.*

**C: Amen.**

[ *All return to their places and Sudanese Choir come forward.*]
